3. Current electric and gas bills. The issue date on the bill(s) should be within 30-60 days. If utilities are included in your rent, please provide a current lease agreement or rent receipt that states the following:
 - * Applicant's Name
 - * Applicant's Address
 - * Landlord Name and Telephone Number
 - * Statement "Utilities included in rent"
 - * Current Receipt
 - * Rent Amount
4. Proof of AABD or TANF, you must bring the "Medical Eligibility Card"
5. Proof of home ownership is required for emergency furnace.
