KIDTEK aims to offer hands-on use of technology and help bridge the gap between education, business and the community.

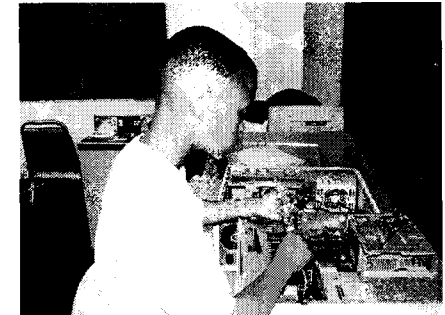
We aim to:
